The Holy Quran' frequently stressed marriage and marital relationship e.g « He who created you from a single » « psych » (person) and out of it, its mate, in order that he might dwell in her. Al A'araf 189, in order to diagnose sexual dysfunctions and treat them, it is essential to understand the nature, functions and factors affecting normal sexual relationship. These variables have been explicitly explained in the holy Quoran' and Sunna (the prophet's sayings) The paper discusses the functions of sexual intercourse in Islamic literature, the clinical picuture and impact of its dysfunctions, sexual development maturity and adequate performance as well as teachings on frequency, fore play, techinques, preparation and consent and duress.
