General drug information apps



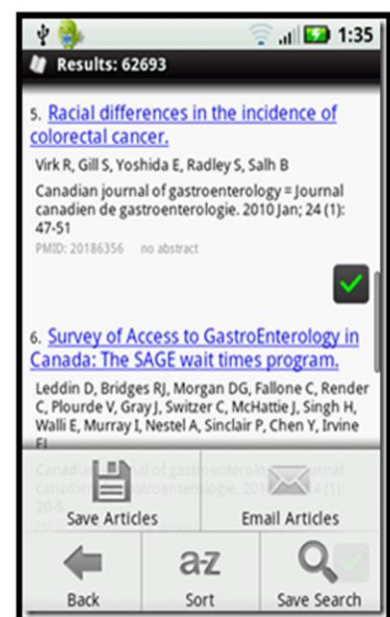
Skyscape



Many Android users will download Skyscape simply to get the Archimedes, a highly useful collection of 100s of commonly used medical calculators. Skyscape, however, does have other medical resources for health care professionals and students. For Android users with OS v1.5 or lower who cannot run Epocrates, one of Skyscape's main features "Rx Drugs" is a fine substitute. Outlines in Clinical Medicine (OCM) comes with the free version, and is particularly useful for students learning a new topic in medicine (e.g. pediatric vaccination schedules). Users, however, will find many of Skyscape's more-robust features unavailable in the free-edition.

PubMed Mobile

As we reviewed previously, PubMed Mobile is a clean app for quick searches of abstracts on PubMed. It lacks full-text link capability, but allows the user to select and read abstracts, save searches and articles, and send articles to the printer, email, or social networking website.



Epocrates

There are four different versions of Epocrates you can have on your iPhone or iPod Touch. Each version offers different features and subscription fees. The default application in the App Store is free, but in order to get the premium versions you can upgrade either online or through the app.

NAVIGATION:

When the application is opened to the home page you're presented with quick hitting health care facts, summarized literature, or suggestions on how to optimize your Epocrates experience. From here you're given the option to select the tabs on the bottom, "interactions", "Pill ID", "MedMath", and "More".

On the home screen, there is a comprehensive search button where you can search in Diseases (Dx), Drugs (Rx), Infectious Diseases (ID), Lab Tests (Lab), Resource Centers (RC), and Tables (Tbl). Most of these sections of search will only yield readable results if you have the premium versions of the app.

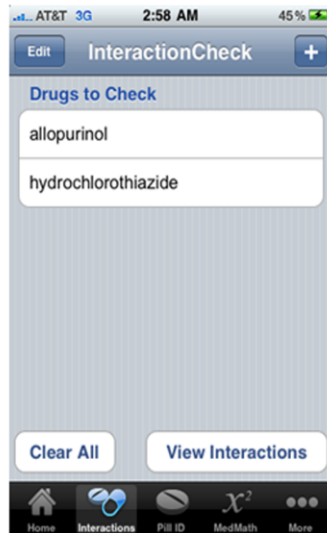
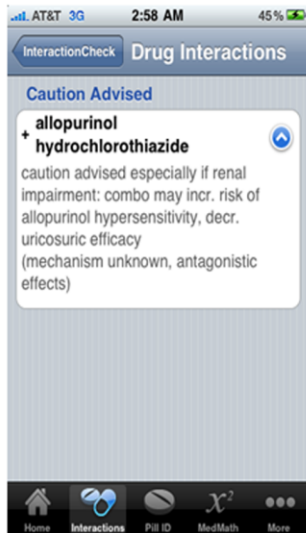
The application is definitely quick, and the user interface is extremely clean and easy to use.

Now, I'm starting from the most basic version of Epocrates available to the most premium version – the more premium versions contain all the features mentioned in the less expensive versions, along with extra features.

EPOCRATES RX – FREE VERSION – KEY FEATURES:

- Drug Interactions – This feature is one of the most popular offered by Epocrates and is a crucial tool used by health care providers at the point of care. Very useful with geriatric patients who can be on multiple drug cocktails at one time.

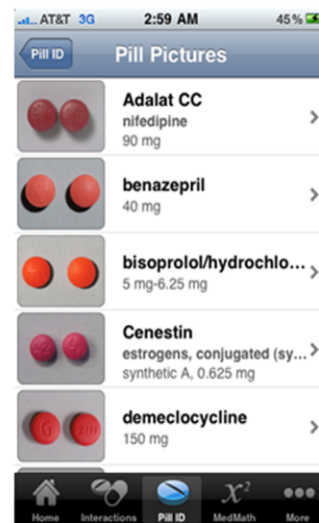
- Pill Identifier – Pill pictures: One of the coolest features offered by Epocrates. This feature was getting huge amounts of hype when the first iPhone 2G was released. My own peers in the medical field were contemplating getting an iPhone for this innovative feature alone – they didn't – but that's the type of excitement it generated.

- Drug Info – Information on thousands of drugs.

This includes mechanism of action, pharmacology, drug pricing, ability to add custom notes, and all the other basic drug info you could possibly want.

- MedMath – When the free version of Epocrates first rolled out this feature was lacking in functionality.

Thier is other medical calculators, and although this portion of the app does not contain the same volume of equations as other calculators, the equations it does have are more than satisfactory. Some key equations I've found useful are the dosing calculator, Osmolarity, and the Parkland Burn formula. There's even a formula for number needed to treat!

This Gastroenterology app is a critical tool for anyone - not just Gastroenterologists managing patients with gastrointestinal and/or liver disease.

- * Does your patient require admission and possible intervention for their upper GI bleeding (Blatchford score)?

Liver Calc is a medical calculator with 15 commonly used formulas tailored for hepatologist. Developed by hepatologist from Center for Liver Health, The Chinese University of Hong Kong, livercalc helps physicians and nurses calculate the score in a most handy and easy way. Formulas include:

CUHK-HCC Score, MELD Score, MELD-Na Score, PELD Score, Child-Pugh, Maddrey Score (For alcoholic hepatitis), Mayo, Score (for PBC), Autoimmune hepatitis, RUCAM criteria, Fibroscan algorithm, AST / ALT Ratio, APRI, Forns index, Hui index, FIB4, NAFLD Fibrosis, score in Chinese, BARD.



eGFR



From the National Kidney Foundation (NKF), this application allows medical professionals to estimate kidney function using five separate eGFR calculators:

- CKD-EPI Creatinine Equation (Preferred method)
- MDRD Study Equation
- Cockcroft-Gault Formula
- CKD-EPI Cystatin and Creatinine 2008 Equation
- Revised Bedside Schwartz Formula (For ages 1-17)

CRRT

Gambro's CRRT Calc was specifically developed for Critical Care professionals including Nephrologists, Intensivists, Fellows and Nurses managing Acute Kidney Injury (also known as Acute Renal Failure) patients using Continuous Renal Replacement Therapy (CRRT). The Gambro CRRT Calc enables users to calculate Fluid Accumulation on Acute Kidney Injury patients. The Gambro CRRT Calc also allows the user to compare their Calculated Prescribed Dose vs. their actual Delivered Dose using the CRRT Dose Calculator.

The Model for End-Stage Liver Disease (MELD) and the Pediatric End-stage Liver Disease (PELD) are an index of severity of liver disease. The MELD is scored for people over 12 years, and the PELD for children under 12 years. It indicates how urgently the patient needs a transplant within the next 3 months.

This application calculates the Meld and Peld score following the UNOS (United Network for Organ Sharing) modification.

Kidney Function Calculator

Accurate Kidney Function Calculator. If you are a nephrologist or a renologist, this app can simplify your life a bit. It determines a given patient's glomerular filtration rate using the MDRD, CKD-EPI, or Mayo Quadratic methods. It also calculates the creatinine clearances which is used to estimate GFR using the regular method as well as the Cockcroft-Gault formula. You can also choose to normalize these values with the patient's Body Surface Area. It is simple to use and made universal, allowing the practitioner to choose from a plethora of units for each of the parameters (i.e. mg/dL, mmol/L, etc...)



GFR & BSA Calculator Ver1.0

Glomerular filtration rate (GFR) is the best overall index of kidney function. Normal GFR varies according to age, sex, and body size, and declines with age.

Software use Cockcroft-Gault (for GFR) and the DuBois formula (for BSA) to show value in mL/min/1.73m². It be recommend by NKF's KDOQI clinical practice guidelines to estimate GFR.

Clinical Lab (Glomerular filtration rate) Dr.Ho

Renal function is an indication of the state of the kidney and its role in renal physiology. Glomerular filtration rate (GFR) describes the flow rate of filtered fluid through the kidney. Creatinine clearance rate (CCr or CrCl) is the volume of blood plasma that is cleared of creatinine per unit time and is a useful measure for approximating the GFR. A commonly used surrogate marker for estimate of creatinine clearance is the Cockcroft-Gault formula, which in turn estimates GFR in ml/min. It is named after the scientists who first published the formula, and it employs serum creatinine measurements and a patient's weight to predict the creatinine clearance.
