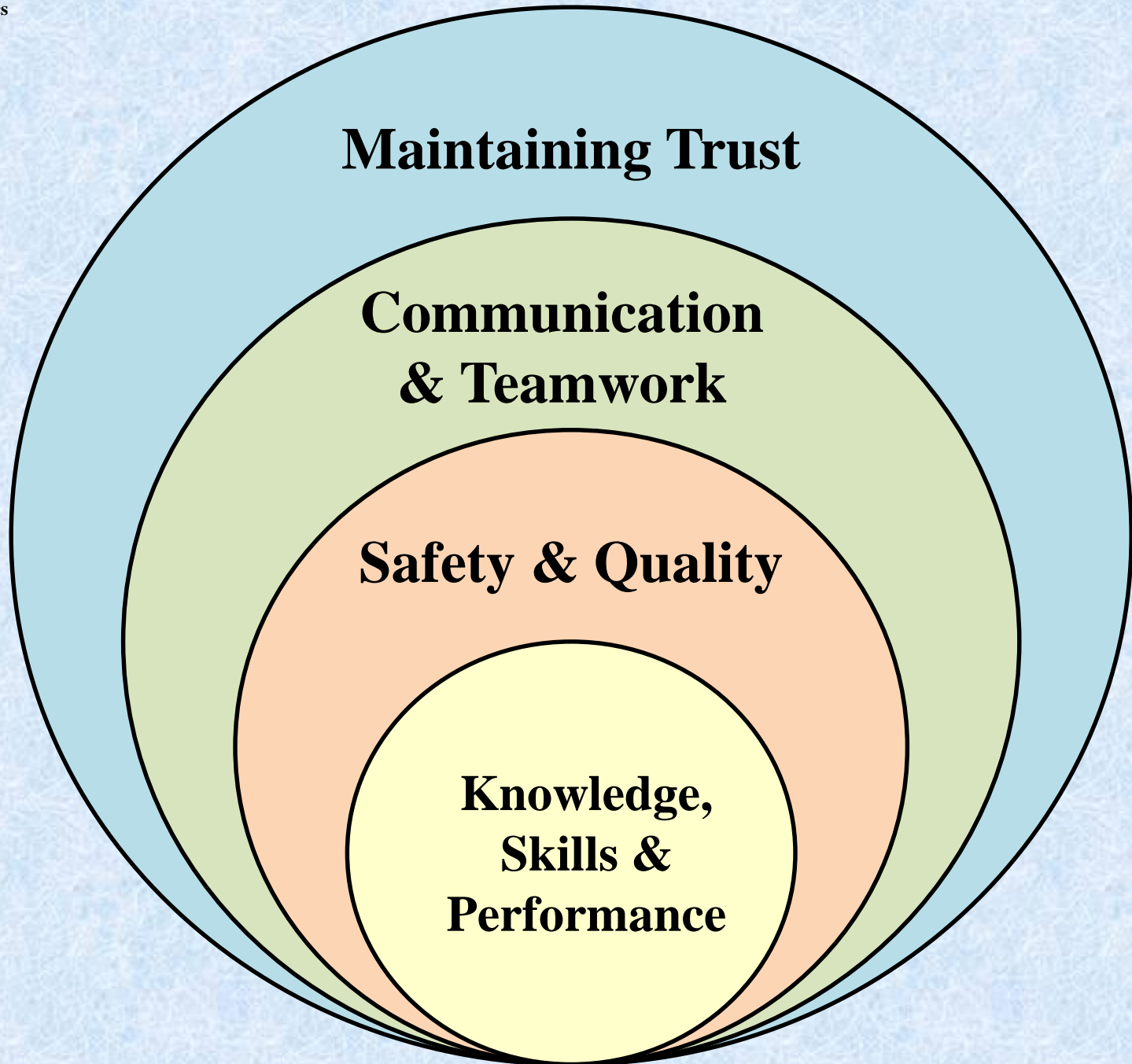

Knowledge, Skills & Performance

- Make the care of your patients your first concern.**
- Provide a good standard of practice and care:**
 - **Develop and maintain your professional performance.**
 - **Apply knowledge and experience to practice.**
 - **Recognize and work within the limits of your competence.**
 - **Record your work clearly, accurately and legibly.**

Safety & Quality

- Contribute to and comply with systems to protect patients.**
- Respond to risks toward safety.**
- Protect patients and colleagues from any risk posed by your health.**

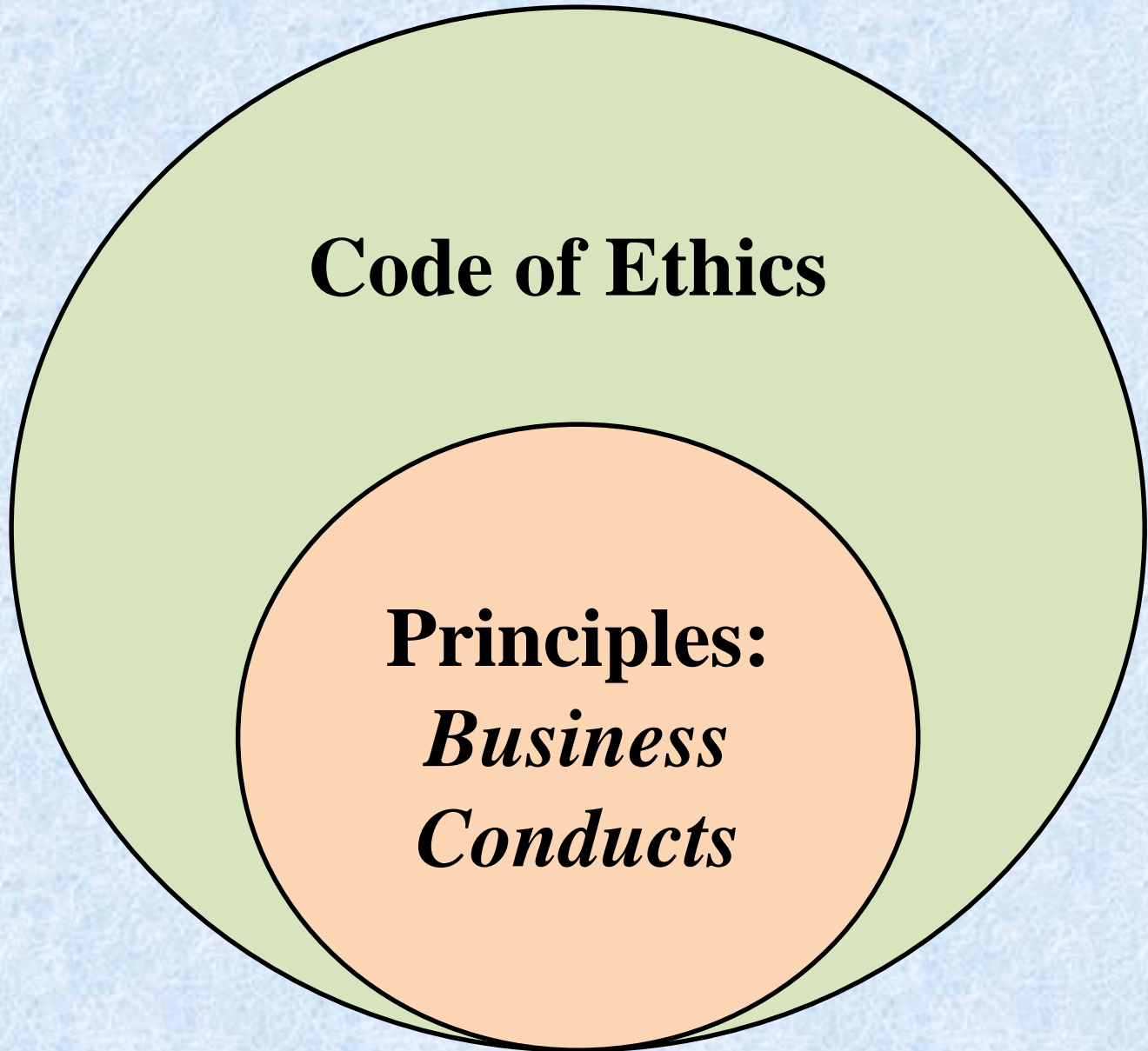
Communication, Partnership & Teamwork

- Communicate effectively.**
- Work collaboratively with colleagues to maintain or improve patient care.**
- Teaching, training, supporting and assessing.**
- Continuity and co-ordination of care.**
- Establish and maintain partnerships with patients:**

Maintaining Trust

- Show respect for patients.**
- Treat patients and colleagues fairly and without discrimination.**
- Act with honesty and integrity.**
- Never abuse your patients' trust in you or the public's trust in the profession.**

IEEE: Business Conduct



Principles of Business Conduct (1/2)

- Make it clear that IEEE requires fair dealings with all involved parties**
- Avoid conflicts of interest**
- Maintain confidentiality of information entrusted to IEEE**
- Assure that IEEE's assets are only used for IEEE purposes**

Principles of Business Conduct (2/2)

- Protect ownership of assets developed under initiatives of IEEE**
- Provide full disclosure of financial transactions of IEEE in its reports to volunteers and management**
- Comply with applicable laws, rules, and regulations**
- Notify IEEE Corporate Integrity Officer if ...**

IEEE Code of Ethics: (1) *Responsibility*

**To accept *responsibility* in making decisions
consistent with the safety, health, and
welfare of the public, &
to disclose promptly factors that might
endanger the public or the environment**

IEEE Code of Ethics: (2) *Conflict of Interest*

To avoid real or perceived *conflicts of interest* whenever possible, & to disclose them to affected parties when they do exist

IEEE Code of Ethics: (3) *Honest & Realistic*

**To be honest and realistic
in stating claims or estimates
based on available data**

consequences**

IEEE Code of Ethics: (6) *Seeking Competence*

**To maintain and improve our technical
competence and
to undertake technological tasks for others
only if qualified by training or experience,
or after full disclosure of pertinent
limitations**

IEEE Code of Ethics: (7) *Honest Criticism*

**To seek, accept, and offer *honest criticism*
of technical work,
to acknowledge and correct errors, and
to credit properly the contributions of others**

IEEE Code of Ethics: (8) *Fairness*

**To *treat fairly all persons* and
to not engage in acts of discrimination based on
race, religion, gender, disability, age, national
origin, sexual orientation, gender identity, or
gender expression**

their property,
reputation, or employment
by false or malicious action**
