Question1: Multiple choices - Choose the correct answer from the following:

- 1) You have just set up two shared printers from Windows Server 2008, and you also plan to manage four other network printers from the server. Your plan is to manage all of these printers using the Print Management tool, but the tool does not appear on the Administrative Tools menu. What is the problem?
 - a) The Print Management tool is only available to local printers.
 - b) You must first enable use of the Print Management tool in the default domain policy.
 - c) You need to install the Print Services role.
 - d) The Print Management tool is only a command-line tool, and you must start it from the Command Prompt window.

- 2) Your department manager is in a hurry to print his report for the managers meeting that starts in 20 minutes, but the printer currently has 32 print jobs that might take more than 20 minutes to print. You are the print server administrator in the department. How can you help your department manager?
 - a) Delete the 32 print jobs and send a message to users to resubmit them.
 - b) Pause the printer and then use the Pause option to print a single document by ID number while the other documents are paused.
 - c) Open that printer's print window and drag the print job to the top of the print queue.
 - d) Open that printer's print window and change the priority of the print job to 99 in that print job's properties.

- 3) You are the print server administrator in King Saud University (KSU), you add a new printer to the network and you want to share it so, you enabled sharing from the sharing tab of the printer's properties and provided a name for the shared printer to be "ksup10". But users in the network couldn't see this new shared printer "ksup10". What do you think is the reason?
 - a) The name of the share printer is not suitable.
 - b) You did not check list in active directory.
 - c) You should install the printer drive in all the users' computers.
 - d) The printer is corrupted.

2. Users with Manage Documents permissions have the ability to manage the shared printers print permissions for all the printers in the network. ()
3. Print queue is a stack of print jobs, with the last job submitted at the top of the stack and the first job submitted at the bottom. ()
4. If you are printing a document that has 3 pages and then you pause the printing after you print only the first page, because the font style was not correct in all the 3 pages and you want to print the whole document again with a new font style you use the Restart option in the Document menu on the printer window. ()
5. In the Internet printing, the client sends the printing job to the Server Service in the Print Server. ()
