Description:

The objective of the Research's Project is to develop the student's ability to carry out and contribute to Health Administration Research. The student should demonstrate, through his/her project and orally, an ability to plan, conduct, and present a scientific investigation of relevance to the subject of Health Administration. A further aim is to develop skills for the critical examination of investigations and research reports and to provide the student with the opportunity for a deeper level of theoretical and practical study within a chosen area.

Conduct of the Project:

The Research's Project work should prove the student's independent abilities to investigate an issue within the field of Health Administration. The emphasis lies on the critical choice of method, the creation of a relevant theoretical frame of reference, and an in-depth analysis of the theoretical and empirical material. Further, the student must identify a possibility to contribute to the existing literature in a chosen subject or problem area, and make a significant and realistic effort to make this contribution. The methodology discussions must be clearly connected to the problem area and the different parts must be well integrated as a harmonized unity. Each student will be assigned a project's supervisor. It is then the student's responsibility to conduct the work and coordinate with the designated project supervisor in a timely manner by the following schedule*:

- Week One: Student's orientation about the research project conducted by research projects coordinator.
- Week Two: Student, after coordinating with his supervisor, should choose and decided the topic of his project.

- Week Thee: Project proposal (the first three chapters of the project) should be submitted to and be approved by the project's supervisor.
- Week Twelve: Project (Five chapters' project) should be submitted to and be approved by the project's supervisor.
- Week Fourteen: Project (Five chapters' project) should Presented using a Power Point in presence of a committee, other projects students, and other interested audiences. Each project will be given 10 Minutes to be presented.
- Week Fifteen: Project's final draft (after making modification requested by the committee members) should submitted to the department. The students will be required to prepare four hard copies and one electronic copy of the final research project; and electronic copies of the presentation.

<u>Note</u>: the student will be responsible for submitting the project's requirements on time otherwise will be bear the responsibility of be given Incomplete grade by the project's supervisor for not fulfilling the project's requirement in a timely manner.

Grading:

The final grade will be based on the following:

Pass if student fulfill the project's requirements.

Incomplete if the student didn't fulfill the project's requirements on schedule time. Student could be given another semester to finish the project requirements by the recommendation of the project supervisor.

Fail if the student didn't fulfill the project's requirements.
