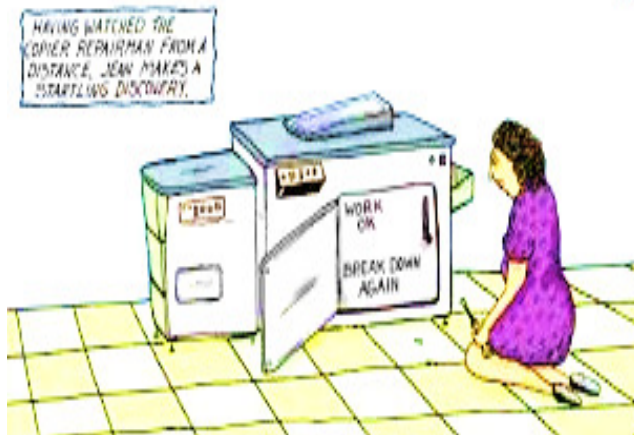

Asking and Answering Questions in the Simple Past Tense

1. Yes/No Questions:

Did + Subject + main verb (infinitive) + compliment ?

Answer: Yes, + [Subject] + **did**.

OR: No, [Subject] + **didn't**.

2. WH. Questions:

Wh. Word + **did** + Subject + main verb (infinitive) + compliment +? .

Answer: [Subject] + main verb (**past**) + compliment .

Asking and Answering Questions in the Past Continuous Tense

1. Yes/No Questions:

Question: **Was/Were** + Subject + **main verb (ing)** + compliment ?

Answer: Yes, + [Subject] + **was/were**.

OR: No, [Subject] + **wasn't/weren't**.

2. WH. Questions:

Question: Wh. Word + **Was/Were** + Subject + **main verb (ing)** + compliment +? .

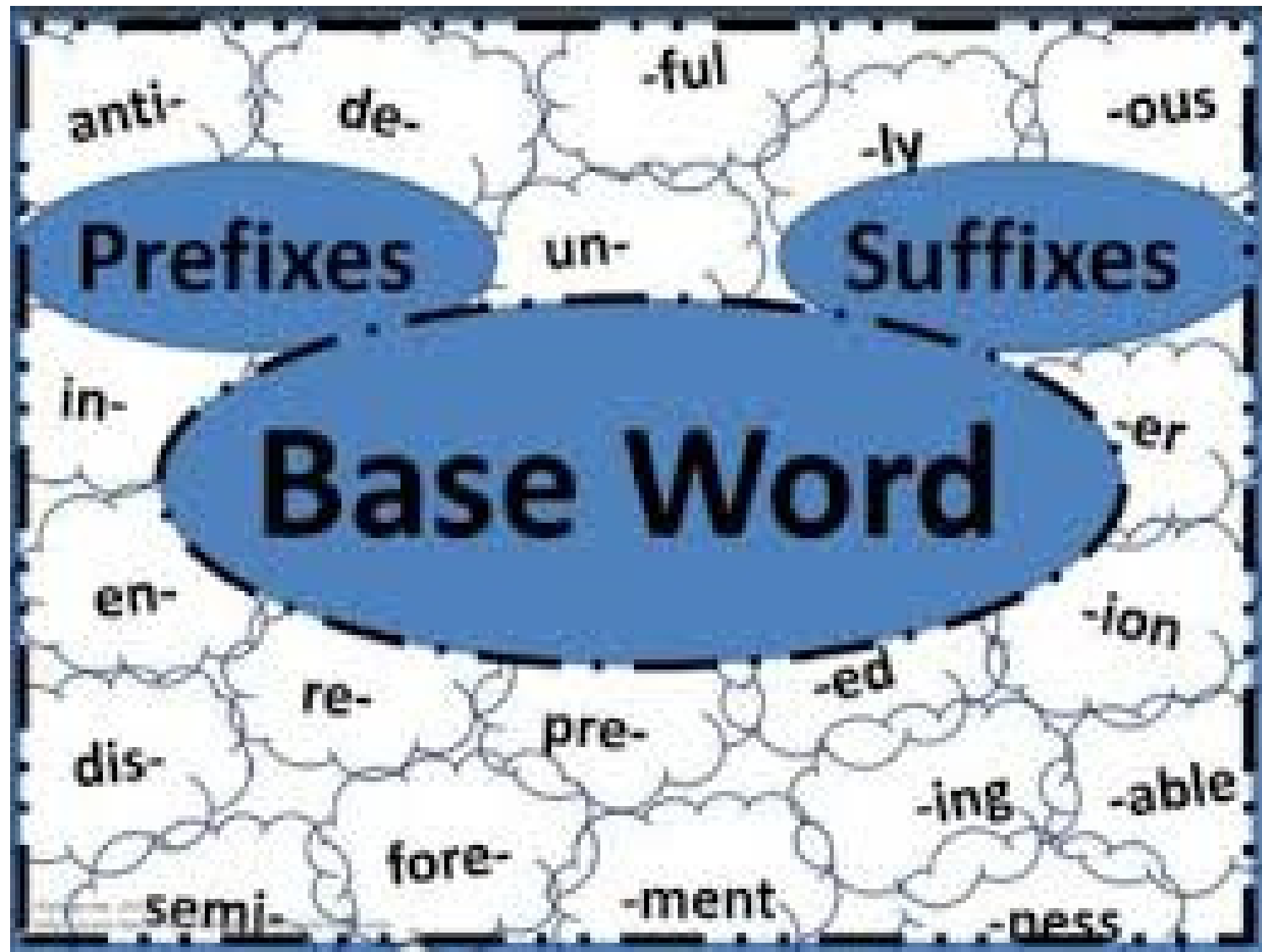
Answer: [Subject] + **Was/Were** + **main verb (ing)** + compliment .






- go at the beginning of words

bi-	(two)	bicycle 	
dis-	(not)	dislike 	
mis-	(wrong)	misbehave 	
over-	(too much)	overcook 	
pre-	(before)	prehistoric 	
re-	(to do again; back)	remade return 	
un-	(not)	unhappy

Time Expressions

- When we say dates, we must use ordinals instead of numbers.

- For example: 3/4/ 1999

we say: **The** third **of** April, nineteen ninety nine

- **1900: Nineteen hundred**
- **1905: Nineteen oh five**
- **2001: Two thousand and one**
- **2002: Two thousand and two**
- **2012: Two thousand and twelve**

Linking Word	Meaning	Example
While	<i>A conjunction</i> that connects two clauses. It means 'at the same time'	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- I met Peter while I was studying in New York.- While I was studying in New York, I met Peter.
During	<i>A preposition</i> that is followed by a <i>noun</i> . It means 'throughout'.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- I worked on a farm during the holidays.- I met Mark during my stay in New York.
For	<i>A preposition</i> that is followed by a <i>period of time/time expression</i> . It answers the question: <i>How long?</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- I lived there for three years.- I exercised for two hours.
